Lessons:

Private lessons \$50/hr

Group lessons \$40/hr per student

Private lesson package \$400 for 10 lesson hours. (Package only available for those taking weekly lessons on-site at FCF.)

FCF lesson horses available and haul-ins are welcome too. No additional charges.

Off-site lessons: An additional .40/mile round trip will apply. Away lesson requests are due on the 25th of the month prior for scheduling purposes.

Horse Training:

Full training with pasture board \$800/month; with stall board \$1000/month

Part training with pasture board \$700/month; with stall board \$900/month

Individual training session boarders \$30; non-boarders \$40

Boarding:

All boarding includes full use of facilities, 24/7 access to quality hay, large pastures with small group turnout (2-4 horses), grain (Crypto Aero or Tribute) twice a day (will add-in supplements), night check, heated water troughs during cold season, blanketing/boots/sheets/fly masks/fly spray, etc. as needed, scheduling horse for routine hoof and health care if desired with barn preferred professionals (or you can schedule your own preference).

Stall board also includes matted stall overnight with newspaper bedding, plenty of hay, and heated bucket in cold season. Stalls are cleaned daily.

Pasture Board \$400/month

Stall Board \$600/month

Holding fee for appointments: \$10

30 minute exercise and/or grooming session: \$15

Full Circle Farm Memberships:

Membership allows for unlimited haul-ins (no haul-in fee for clinics too), use of the facility, and an option for vacation boarding.

Individual membership \$100/month

Family membership \$150/month

Vacation boarding \$15/day pasture; \$20/day stall

Facility Fees:

Haul-ins \$20/day; student rate \$15/day

Overnight stall \$30/night; student rate \$25/night; members \$10/night

Electrical hook-ups \$20/night; student/member rate \$15/night

Dry camping \$15/night; student/member rate \$10/night

House bedrooms \$30/night; student/member rate \$25/night

Cancellation Policy:

Beginning in 2018, Full Circle Farm & Courtney Clarke now have a cancellation policy for lessons and events.

Lessons

Lessons will only be canceled in the case of an emergency or extreme weather conditions. Lessons can be canceled up to 48 hours prior to a scheduled lesson without penalty. Lessons canceled less than 48 hours in advance will be charged 50% of value of the lesson. Lessons canceled less than 24 hours in advance will be charged 100% of value of the lesson.

Clinics, Courses & Workshops

Clinics, courses and workshops will only be canceled in the case of unexpected emergencies or unforeseen circumstances. If you are unable to attend an event you have signed up for there will be no penalty if your spot is filled from the wait-list or if you can fill your spot. If your spot can't be filled from the wait-list and your cancellation notice is more than 2 weeks in advance of the event, the full event fee can be applied to another future event within 6 months of the original event. If cancellation notice is given less than 2 weeks ahead of the event, a 50% cancellation fee will be charged and the remaining 50% can be applied to an event within the next 6 months. In the event of cancellation due to an emergency, full amount can be applied to future event within 6 months regardless of when cancellation notice is given.

Cancellations for Visiting Instructor Events are set by the visiting instructor.
